Summer brings on Father's Day, Rosé Month, July 4, and of course, vacations. You'll need lots of wine. Here's the latest slew of recommended bottles to uncork for the non-stop sizzling season!

Gentleman Farmer, Napa Valley, California

June is national rosé month, but you won't need another reason, like Father's Day, to gift or uncork these beauties. The 2021 Gentleman Farmer Napa Valley rosé is one hundred percent pinot noir, resulting in an intense pink hue and complex, rounded dry wine with flavors of watermelon, white tea, celery leaf and a grapefruit kiss on the finish (\$35). Its balanced 2020 Napa chardonnay (\$49) is just as stunning. In honor of Pride month, a portion of proceeds from its 2018 Napa Almanac cabernet sauvignon (\$149) will be donated to the It Gets Better Project, whose mission is to connect LGBTQ+ around the world.
